hartered captains require Chartered captains 12.1 around five or six people, to set sail. Both clubs help individual members who are interested in going on fishing trips to get groups together so they can take captained boats out on the water.

Both clubs do this free of charge.

These groups can lead to friendships within the clubs, said Thompson, of the Village of St. Charles.

During the event, members of the clubs filled Everglades Recreation's largest room with fishing gear of all sorts including lures, rods, tackle boxes, buckets, reels and tools. Most of the attendees were there to sell parts of their vast collections.

"We overbuy, I'm guilty of it myself," said Deep Sea Fishing Club Social Media Director Al Anderson, of the Village of Briar Meadow. "Some of these guys realize they have a dozen more reels than what they need to."

Some club members brought entire crates full of gear to sell.

Multiple people walked out of Everglades carrying boxes of newly purchased supplies.

The event also served to generate interest in the clubs, as both clubs had tables set up with more information and sheets for signing up. The Deep Sea Fishing Club had a video playing showing some of the highlights of their previous fishing expeditions.

Joint effort events between the clubs are going to become a regular occurrence after the success of the swapmeet, said Fowler.


The Deep Sea Fishing Club meets at 6 p.m. on the first Monday of every month at **Everglades Recreation.** The Freshwater Fishing
